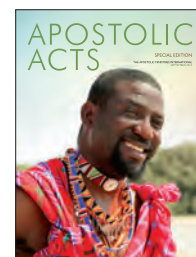

SHOW ME YOUR *Glory*

The 'Glory of God' is a prominent theme in the word of God. Its theological significance is understood as we study deeply the words used for it in the Hebrew and in the Greek.

In Hebrew it is called Kabod which means to be heavy or weighty and the Greek word 'Doxa' is defined as 'to give a proper opinion of someone or something'. However to derive a practical application and for our hearts to be stirred up to a deeper communion with God, we need to comprehend the practical implication of this word.

'Glory of God' simply means that which is invisible with God is made manifest in the visible for others to behold and marvel. It is the invasion of God into our present realities. For anyone who knows the awesomeness, faithfulness, power and majesty of God but still seeks to see it displayed in the visible, the answer is 'God's glory'.

Let me list some of the blessing associated with the Glory of God in the Bible.

PRESERVATION:

The root word 'Shakein' often translated 'to dwell' is a word commonly used to describe the 'shekinah glory of God'. It is interesting to observe that Moses relates to God as the one who dwelt (shekan) in the bush (Deuteronomy 33:16). No wonder the bush when seen enflamed still remained unconsumed. The Lord's glory preserved the bush from being charred into non existence.

PROVISION:

God announced through Moses that He will supernaturally provide for His people. However He specified that the provision will be a result of God manifesting His glory (Exodus 16:7-10).

PROTECTION:

It was the glory of God that prevented the Egyptians from getting close to the Israelites at the Red Sea. God's glory becomes our protection (Exodus 14:8,9,10).

DIVINE APPOINTMENT:

God's glory often becomes the platform upon which divine dictates were given. It became the place where God communed with Moses and gave him direction. The Tabernacle of God became the tent of meeting when God's glory filled it (Exodus 29:42). The word used for 'meeting' is the word 'appointment' in Hebrew. Any manifestation of God's glory is God making an appointment to meet His people. I pray that we will be diligent to keep such divine appointment even when it seems inconvenient.

WHAT IS THE SECRET TO ENCOUNTER GOD'S GLORY?

The scripture speaks in Psalms 91:1 'He that dwells in the secret place of the most High shall abide under the shadow of the Almighty'. The shadow of the Almighty is nothing but His enveloping glory. The key however is to dwell in the secret place of the Most High. The word 'Most High' is the word 'El Elyon' in Hebrew which means 'The possessor of heaven & earth'. The first mention of this word is by Abraham when he addressed the kings that he had helped to be set free. Abraham when he said, 'I have lift up mine hand unto the LORD, the most high God, the possessor of heaven and earth', he was allowing us to have a glimpse of his journey of faith as far as his personal conviction goes. In his refusal to accept any shortcut to wealth and fame, Abraham was reinforcing his faith in the God that He called 'El Elyon' and whom he knew as the one who owns everything and all both in Heaven and on Earth. If a child of God can find his secret place in the revelation of 'El Elyon' he would be preparing himself for an encounter with the 'glory of God'.

The inadequacy of human resource is often the platform for God to reveal His glory. The shortage of wine at the wedding of Cana became the optimum moment for Jesus to showcase His glory. 'Let's hide in El Elyon' the owner of heaven and earth and find our source in Him for everything that we need for the present and for the future and be blessed by the wings of His glory under which we shall find true refuge.

My Story, My Life

MY EARLY YEARS

Born on December 12, 1971 to a French woman, in Cameroon, I have never met my father. My mother conceived me at a young and tender age of 19, and being the first born of her 5 children, she was left to face the world by herself.

The lack of a 'Father' figure in our family, made it difficult for my mother to support us financially and emotionally. Seeking comfort, and the lack of a role model led me to join hands with people much older to me in age and who were lost fully into the world. My company of friends were mainly people of the streets, with whom I engaged in robbery, theft, money laundering business.

For almost 17 years of my life, I wasted away, chasing money and living the illusion called 'powerful and luxurious' life. But in the inside, I was lost. Amidst all this I got introduced to spirit worship, and started taking guidance for doing daily life from an evil spirit. In short, I was a total wreck, a man with broken emotions, leading a lifestyle soaked in the filth of the world and influenced by an evil spirit.

Despite my wayward lifestyle, my mother believed and earnestly prayed that God would encounter me.

A GODLY INTERVENTION

In 2003, I happened to go for a church meeting, where I came across a Black – American preacher, Bishop Walter Smith who prophetically brought forth a word of knowledge revealing my entire life. This man, assured that though everything in my life was a mess, that God in His mercy, had a beautiful purpose over my life. After the service, as Bishop Walter Smith was a visitor to that church, he handed me over to a man of God, Venon Fernandes, who ministered to me, and anchored me in the Word. He was the person that God used to introduce me to the Africa On Fire For Jesus hosted by TAMI in 2003.


I attended the classes for two months. The International School of Discipleship changed me drastically as the sweet Holy Spirit took over my life. I experienced total deliverance and my life was whole again. He not only brought beauty from ashes but equipped me with His Gifts to build the Body of Christ, which I did not comprehend at that moment.

My legal problems were not over. I had to frequently visit the court as I had a legal case against me for \$ 300,000. Right after the bible was the awaiting of the prison doors.

MY TIME IN PRISON

Spend a total of 7 years in Butimba Prison, Tanzania. Here I ministered to over 600 people during my term. This prison, during my time had about 1400 inmates. I used to hold regular meetings in the prison and have led hundreds of people to the saving knowledge of Jesus Christ.



Attacks of the enemy in every direction was something that led me remembering my past and paved way to guilt that burdened me. God never left me and spoke - Job 22:30, which reads: "He delivers even the one who is not innocent, who will be delivered through the cleanness of your hands." Having encountered the Holy Spirit in a mighty way, my life has never been the same. I have witnessed marvellous deliverances, healing and watched people set free of afflictions that has tormented them for years.

During my time in the prison, I used to hold meetings every day, and see hundreds of people set free. The prison capacity was originally 600, but it housed over 1400 inmates, almost 4 times the capacity. The meetings brought immense peace into the prison, as now people started, repenting, and encountering God on a level like never before. This was appreciated and encouraged by the commissioner.

CELL MEETINGS

We have a total of 3 Cells taking place in Yaoundé City, which caters to approximately 150 people.

SUNDAY SCHOOL

Our Sunday School takes place 40 children attends the Sunday school at our church. The age group ranges with the youngest member of 2 years to the oldest member of 12 years.

NIGHT VIGIL

Weekly once, every Friday night, from 10PM to 6AM, we hold a continuous prayer session, contending for the nation and the spreading of the Gospel to the ends of the earth.

PRISON MEETING

The prison meetings reaches out to about 150 inmates of the Yaoundé Central Prison. With special permission and support from the Police Commissioner, we have appointed Pastor Abiga to run our Prison Ministry.

NATIONAL PRAYER

Upon the vision given by God, and a woman who willingly contributed 3000 USD, I organized a national prayer for the National Elections for the year 2011. The prayer meeting was organized in the Yaoundé Football Stadium, on September 30, 2011, from 10PM to 6AM. There was great opposition we faced and these were our very own Christian brothers who opposed the godly idea. But we stood to our resolve, and gathered together and prayed for the election and the peace of the nation. This meeting was attended by a representative from the President's Office. Despite the rain, and all other opposition, God's people prayed whole night to see peace in the nation. The meeting was attended by members of various churches namely Pentecostals, protestants, Roman Catholics.

Subsequently the elections took place and Mr. Paul Biya was elected as the President. The prayer movement was rewarded an amount of 8000 USD and a letter as token of appreciation from the President.

WOMEN'S CONFERENCE

Hosted a Women's Conference on Woman's Day (March 8), with about 400 women gathering.

SCHOOL IN CAMEROON

We almost had to stop press to include this very delightful mission report from Pastor Daniel Batela in Cameroon. We are so happy and proud to inform everyone that under the aegis of TAMI and the able leadership and commitment of Pastor Daniel and his church, a new school has recently been constructed in Lelene, Ngyola, in east Cameroon!! Lelene is about 700km from the capital city, Yaounde. Construction of the first two classrooms for the Nursery and Primary school is almost done even as this magazine heads out for printing. This is a school for a pygmy village and despite challenges that Pastor Daniel and his family have had to undergo in the past year, he simply calls it a “season of increasing responsibilities” and says that “It is WELL!”

Aid and assistance came in from unexpected but divinely inspired contacts. A wood company (GRACOVIR), which is based around the community, supported the school construction project with planks worth over 10000 USD. Another one supported the



school with services of a caterpillar which graded and levelled the site for the construction. We applaud and thank these two companies and bless them for their generosity. May the Lord give them unprecedented increase for their goodness?

There still remains a lot to be accomplished— the school needs housing facilities for the teachers. There are financial challenges in order to complete the constructions and officially register the school for it to become operational. The present capacity of the school is for 300 children but since there are only two classrooms, the attendance will be restricted to 120 children (60 in each class). More classes are expected to be added every year. School term has already started in the region and this school is keen to start immediately. In an act of faith, Pastor Daniel and his team have had the school uniforms stitched, and have bought course books and writing materials for the kids. The school is about to get started with two teachers and the minimal facilities they have at present.

Pastor Alias has received this news with great joy and on behalf of TAMI, he has assured Pastor Daniel of adequate financial support along with books and syllabus for the school. The proposed name for this school is Caritas Global School and we look forward to many more of such projects to start in these villages to provide a wholesome growth for children.



Mozambique Bible School

Yet, another splendid journey with the Holy Spirit to Beira, Mozambique.

When nations are opened up for the sake of the Gospel, it brings a great excitement to all who participate to see the power of the Holy Spirit move in mighty ways. When our hearts are willing to see God's wonders displayed in different parts of the world, He moves in a way that our minds cannot fathom.

A random business trip of Brother Biju Paul of Sharjah Apostolic Church was the beginning point for a great work to start in Beira. This trip blessed him with a divine connection with Pastor Mafumo of the Evangelistic Assemblies of God Church in Beira. According to the Lord's will, this led to the bible school in Beira, Mozambique, that commenced on the 21st of July and continued till the 30th July 2015.

On the 21st morning 200 students consisting of Bishops, Pastors and the church leaders gathered together from 35 different churches in Beira. This displayed a hunger for God in one accord as in Acts 2: 1, "And when the day of Pentecost was fully come, they were all with one accord in one place."

The teaching began on the subject titled, "The Power of the Word of God" by Pastor Prathiba Rao. He also spoke on the requirement of being a committed student in the Bible School by "Receiving, Retaining and Reproducing the Word of God". This was backed up the Holy Spirit that the fire just lit up instantly. It also burned out all the doubts the students had about us- the Indians; and purified their hearts of the fear they had of our intentions to conduct the Bible School in Beira. When they



witnessed how the demons started manifesting as the Word was taught, they had an extreme eagerness to be filled with the Anointing of the Holy Spirit. The impact of the Kingdom increased intensely as the teaching continued on “The Local Church” and the “Five Fold Ministry”.

Pastor Anison Samuel took over and taught on the “Anointing of the Holy Spirit”. This not only kept the fire burning but the students on their feet as the teaching began to practically flow like a river. They were lifted from the physical realm into the spiritual realm and had an experience of being immersed into the river of God. Spectacularly they started to receive the baptism of the Holy Spirit and began speaking in tongues for the very first time. The anointing from the classroom spread to the open air grounds of the government school where Pastor Anison preached to a larger gathering for two nights. Without any official advertisements the place was packed as the students who attended the Bible School invited their relatives and friends by word of mouth. God was faithful to honor the efforts. The whole gathering was “terepente” (Portuguese) meaning suddenly filled with the presence and power of the Holy Spirit. Many personally experienced the healing touch of God. People who were possessed and had demons manifesting, were instantly set free. For this, God alone deserves all the Glory!

Soon Pastor John Benjamin from USA, taught on “Praise and Worship as a Life Style” for a believer. Through this they learned how to be intimate with the Holy Spirit. They were led into long hours of praise and worship in the Spirit which they carried back into their homes and churches.

After Pastor John, I had the opportunity to teach on “Supernatural Faith”. I encouraged the students by giving them practical examples on leading their personal life and ministry by an unwavering faith in Jesus. I also taught on “Changing for Life” through healing and deliverance. This opened their understanding of how the demonic world functions on pursuing to mess up a believer’s life, even without his/her knowledge. At the end of the teaching the students were led to praying and confessing any hidden sin in their lives that has been an open door to the enemy. Many recognized on how they have been targeted by the enemy and came over for counselling and deliverance. By the lavished grace of God, all the students who came forward received their freedom in Jesus; and returned with joy!





Pastor Finny Stephen ended with the teaching on the “Life in the Holy Spirit.” This included the “Gifts of the Holy Spirit” and the “Impartation of the Gifts of the Holy Spirit.” He challenged the students who had a desire to operate in the gifts of the Holy Spirit to come forward. He taught on each gift and prayed for its impartation on everyone present.

During the closing ceremony on the 30th, the governor of the region was invited as the chief guest who thanked the Leaders of The Apostolic Ministries International for coming to Beira, Mozambique. It was an honor for us to have him invite us again to conduct the Bible School.

Every student was awarded with a certificate for regularly attending the bible school. This added to their joy and encouraged them to be rooted in the Word of God.

From the bottom of my heart I extend a big thank you, “Obrigado” in Portuguese to all of you who had sown generously in terms of resources and prayers. God is more than faithful to bless you back in double fold for this abundant heart of yours. Your giving has blessed us to provide food for the students all the days of the bible school. God blessed each and every one who were a part this great move in Beira.

Let His work continue from generation to generations.

Ithanga Village was blessed this summer with the School of Discipleship from 27th August to 3rd August. 80 students from all 28 TAMI churches in Kenya, participated, three of whom also took water baptism. Pastor John Waweru (who is also the National Coordinator for TAMI in Kenya) oversees 28 Churches in Kenya with his gracious wife Mama Lucy.

NEPAL BIBLE SCHOOL



12 teachers from UAE, Canada, USA, India and Nepal joined hands on this mission to Nepal. The Bible School commenced on 17th August and finished on 4th of September 2015. This was the first TAMIL Bible School in this nation. Due to political unrest the nation had declared “Bandh” (strike) with curfew during the day making it difficult for people to attend the school. Such was the hunger of the people who attended, that they somehow managed to make it to the school after the curfew hours late at night.



Following were the areas that the teaching was focused on:

1. Deliverance & Inner healing
2. Holy Spirit and Gifts
3. Prayer and Worship
4. Discipleship and Evangelism
5. Human trafficking – Church’s role
6. Hearing God’s voice and Quiet time
7. Church Planting



Outcome

1. 95% (135 students) received baptism of the Holy Spirit and spoke in tongues for the first time.
2. 6 Students were baptized in the water.
3. 4 Pastors have initiated the process to join TAMI network.
4. 63 students committed to work with Children of Nepal.
5. 105 students committed to start home church.
6. 36 recorded healings in school by the students who received the gift of healing.
7. Deliverance and healing took place at home when students called their homes.
8. Pastor Benjamin Buda Magar of Immanuel Church, Banke experienced revival on September 5th. Many villagers came to see what was going on because people were falling under the anointing when Pastor Alias started to pray - deliverance from demons took place as people went down under the anointing.
9. Father's and men repented for all the abuse done towards women and father's hugged women who were abused. God broke through with healing as many men broke down with weeping and received burden from the Lord concerning modern day slavery (human trafficking).
10. Almost 80% of the students had encounter, visitation, out of body experience, callings and received gifts.

Entry points

¹⁶"Do you not know that you are the temple of God and that the Spirit of God dwells in you?

¹⁷If anyone defiles the temple of God, God will destroy him. For the temple of God is Holy, which temple you are." 1 Corinthians 3:16-17

You are always under observation by the spirit world, the world we cannot see.

punjab

BIBLE SCHOOL

The vibrant and fun filled Indian state of Punjab started its first Bible school in Bhogpur on 23rd August 2015 with 200 students. Most of these were young men and women who came from Uttar Pradesh, Bihar and other districts of Punjab, driven by a hunger to serve God in the mission fields. The school was inaugurated by TAMI President Pastor Anison, who stayed in Punjab for the initial four days. It was taken onwards by Pastor Pratibha Rao who stayed on throughout the duration of the Bible School. Pastor Jagir Masih and Pastor Danish have been the vanguards of the churches in Punjab.

Each one of these students testified of the life changing experience that they had at the school. It was a 9 am to 5 pm study followed by crusades every evening in different districts of Punjab. Pastors Anison, Rao and Alias brought in sound doctrine and set many

students free from traditional and often erroneous teachings of the past. Many of the students came from different social, religious and cultural backgrounds and these teachings have provided a strong foundation for the church of God to now be established.

Healing flowed freely, as did the Spirit of the Lord in these crusades and many people received deliverance from evil spirits. All kinds of demons fled the place in panic amidst screams and manifestations. People who came in sick and ailing, went back whole and restored, thanking and praising God. All kinds of pains and bondages were broken and a grateful





multitude was seen rejoicing. The highlight of these crusades was in Ranipind on the 24th and 25th of August, which was attended by 600 people. Pastor Danish informed us that testimonies of God's goodness and deliverance are still coming in.

In the words of Pastor Jagir Masih "A new wave of the Holy Spirit has now descended upon Punjab" (Pak Rooh ki ek nayee leher Punjab mein uttar aayee hai). Pastor Danish firmly believes that "in the coming days God is going to change all of north India" and he prays that "God will complete his vision and plan for us".

Surinder Pal, lived in village Hiala, District Nava Sheher, Punjab. He was known as Baba Jatawala (long haired tantric). "People believed me to be a wonder, a "magic person" because I performed witchcraft. Through that I used to earn money.....but I was not happy. People respected me as a good man.

Once I was very depressed and on my way to the market. I met a person who gave me a book from his bag and asked "can you read ?".

When Surinder answered that he could read, the man gave him the book and asked him to read with understanding. Surinder went home and read the book, which he was to find out later was the Bible. Two sentences captivated his mind "For the wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord." (Rom.6:23). And do not do the work of Sin (Gal.5:19).

Well it looks like the only ones who left the village are Satan and his contraband goods !!

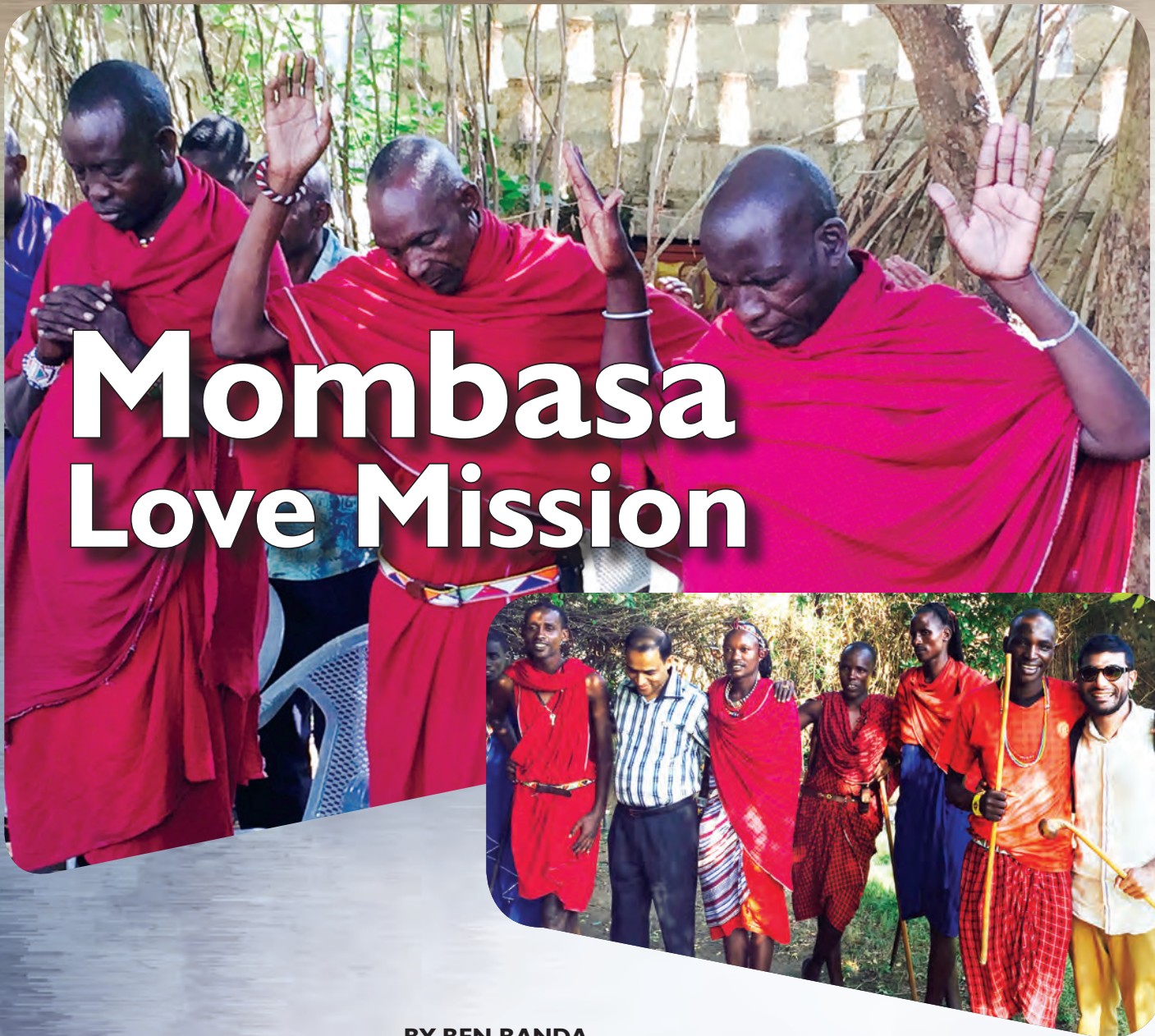

Mombasa Love Mission

A trip to Mombasa, Kenya to the Masai Tribe was one outstandingly memorable for me. I was a part of the team of four that went from The Apostolic Church. I consider this to be great honor and privilege from God to be a part of His ordained assignment.

The Masai groups of people are constantly affected with drought and famine that leads to a lot of impoverishment. Psalm 113: 7-8, "He raises the poor out of the dust and lifts the needy from the ash heap, that he may seat with princes, with princes of His people", reminded me of a hope in God's love and redemption. God's love can lift up anyone and transform them into the sons of God. For the gift of salvation to reach them, we have a responsibility to obey and witness.

I remember Pastor Alias saying on one Friday service, “just one mission journey will change your life.” Oh boy! I experienced that word come to pass with God’s full force. Reaching the unreached for Christ certainly begins with an obedience to the great commission. “Go”, with just that command we left the world of smart phones, microwaves, high risen buildings and super cars, not knowing what to expect. I knew that forty to fifty men would attend the meeting that was organized. But God did exceedingly and abundantly more than we could ever imagine or think.

For three consecutive days over eighty Masai men, women and children came out to sit under a tree, and receive the good news of Jesus. What blew me away was how receptive and hungry they were. It re-affirmed the last part of Matthew 28:20, “and I will be with you until the end of time.” The presence of God was surely in those meetings. I feel that I had seen the best of all on a missionary journey could see, as over twenty Masai men and women gave their lives to Christ and got baptized. The joy to see one surrender all of themselves and is willing to take part in the death and resurrection of Jesus is inexplicable.

I also experienced how people with very little saw joy in the least of all. We played games like musical chairs with just a drumbeat at that. A kid’s heart awakened within me; followed by a



time of pouring out ourselves in worship. It brought me to a point where I started getting convicted of my ungratefulness during many phases of my life.

I will proudly confess, I had my “Peter moment”, on the mountain of transfiguration. The presence of God was so thick and overwhelming, and I wanted to just stay there. If I could be allowed to describe the whole mission in one word, it would be “Blessed” – which means empowered by God. God has certainly planted a seed in Mombasa; it will need watering, nurturing, and continuous prayers. Most importantly it will need more people to, “Go”.

Don’t ever settle to a frame of mind that it’s not important for you to, “Go” on missions. It is never wise to say: “I am not called to be a part of God’s global mission assignments.” Let the words of William Booth





convince you further: “‘Not called!’ did you say?’ Not heard the call,’ I think you should say. Put your ear down to the Bible, and hear him bid you go and pull sinners out of the fire of sin. Then look Christ in the face, whose mercy you have professed to obey and tell him whether you will join heart and soul and body and circumstances in the march to publish His mercy to the world.”

John 20:21, “As my Father has sent Me, even so send I you.” Jesus commanded us to be his witnesses to the ends of the earth. My beloved brothers and sisters if we don’t take responsibility for this task; then who will? We have been given the words of eternal life. We have a message of hope for those in despair. We have the water of life for the thirsty and dying world. Yes, oh yes I know, not all of us can go, but you can undoubtedly do something - Give, pray, desire and obey.

This trip transformed me to a being more like Christ and created a passion that I cannot explain. I encourage all of you to desire to be a part of this great move; especially when our church leaders yearn to see missionaries rise up.

Outcome

- 4 men witnessed Jesus as their personal saviour and received water baptism. Among them, 3 men were from the Masai tribe
- Reached out to over 80 Masai men, by planting the gospel seed into their hearts, which we believe will bear much fruits in the days to come
- Established a firm connection with the Masai tribe leaders and held discussions on the possibility of TAMI setting up a building in Diani, to provide a common place to gather and worship
- 23 Masai men and women gave their lives to Christ and got baptized

Training the Counsellors at Exodus

Pastor Alias addressed three batches of 45 counsellors who are part of the Exodus Church's Ministry of Inner Healing and Deliverance. He spoke to them on the importance of having a clear conscience before God and man, the great need for counsellors to be at rest and peace before they can lead the wounded people to freedom and God's rest. God used him powerfully to challenge the counsellors to increase their time alone with God and have a rich personal prayer time – the ONLY place from where EVERYTHING begins! The effect of his classes were astounding. A GREAT hunger for personal prayer was released among the attendees, which is being practiced even to this very time.

.....To Delhi

I have faced death many times. In March 2006 (9 ½ years ago) I was diagnosed with cancer by some of the best doctors in Delhi. They advised emergency surgery to remove two large tumors from my stomach without which my chances of survival were minimal. I held on to my God's promise that this disease was not for my death but for the Glory of God and that by His stripes I have been healed. With a deep cleansing spiritual counselling from my brother, Pr. Alias, who came immediately from Dubai to Delhi, and also for all the prayer support of



my family and countless people across the world, I literally "jumped over the wall" and got out of the Hospital, against medical advice, on the day of the surgery. Doctors advised me against it and said that I was a walking time-bomb. But I heard the voice of God and am still alive, active, without surgery, without chemotherapy, radiation or any medication. I did not even take a painkiller for a very long time.

All glory to my Saviour and Healer, Jesus Christ.

On many occasions, I have been afflicted with health problems, (usually after some emotional turmoil, bitterness or quarrel), but each time, my Jesus, in His mercy & love, sent His Angels Council whenever I needed them most and has pulled me out of the clutches of death, at the nick of time. He definitely has a purpose for keeping me alive. Let His purpose be fulfilled in my life.

Recently in August 2015, I was afflicted with severe swelling of my legs, redness and pain so immense that I could not walk. It had started in Kerala during a vacation at my sister's house. A renowned physician prescribed antibiotics and painkillers but even after eight days there was no relief. Somehow I returned to Delhi, with unbearable pain, accompanied by my sister, who always came like an angel whenever I needed her most, as I could not have travelled alone in my condition. When I consulted my doctor in Delhi, he found my condition to be an extreme internal infection that he had studied as a rare sample case as a medical student. He even said that if I had come even one week later, consequences would have been very severe, including amputation of leg.

My brother, Pr. Alias and my sister-in-law Annie, who were on their way back from Nepal Mission Trip to Punjab and stopped over at Delhi. He advised me to hold two prayer meetings in my house, on 22nd and 28th August. Though we expected only about 25 people at such a short notice, about 38-40 people came for the meeting on the 25th. The hours that preceded it were a huge challenge, for me, our driver and my housemaid all unwell at the same time! Despite the devil trying his best to prevent the meeting, we went ahead and all of us were greatly blessed by the end. The tangible presence of Holy Spirit was so evident. By the time my brother returned from Punjab on the 28th, my house had witnessed four miracles - My swelling and redness had subsided- about 85% healed which totally amazed my doctor, my housemaid and driver were healed and I no longer required any "urgent" surgery. God proved once again His faithfulness. When we resist the devil and listen to the voice of Holy Spirit in faith, He will show great signs and wonders.

28th Aug. session was attended by about 30 people, though it was a working day. God mightily used my brother to bless many of us and cleansed us with His precious Blood, His written and spoken Word and healed us, spiritually and physically. Some of the things that he spoke about were - all blessings in Christ now available to us; the importance of Christ-consciousness in us; revelation knowledge of the Truth that we are Spirit beings (having a soul, living in a body); daily transforming our soul through personal prayer; crucifying self and leading an offence-free life; rejoicing in our suffering with Christ. He gave a practical demonstration of how we need to overcome devil's devices of making us quarrel with people closest to us, by letting go of our pride and ego, humbling ourselves, seeking forgiveness of those we have offended, loving and blessing them unconditionally, honoring them and not taking justice into our own hands. He emphasized on our character building, keeping a clear conscience, and rejoicing in our infirmities and weaknesses because Jesus is our strength when we are weak and humility is the key to Grace. He also said that the quality of our resurrected body depends on how much we have transformed ourselves, at the time of our death, to the Divine nature of God.

While the above is a brief summary of what God spoke to us through Pr. Alias at Delhi, each one of us need to meditate on all these areas and work it out for our own life with fear & trembling, before correcting others, even in love. All Glory to God

21 Days of Prayer and Fasting 2015

The Prayer and Fasting at ZAMIE this year was in many ways unprecedented and to the glory of God, the beginning of a move of God which the church was praying for years. This move was tremendously breaking forth outside the boundaries of the church building. We had many people from other churches in the city filling up the sanctuary for the meetings that were held in the mornings and evenings. The messages had two distinct themes which continued throughout the Prayer and Fasting. Drawing from the words of Jesus in Mark 4:24, "Be careful what you hear", there were powerful messages on the power of God's Word which is represented by the 'seed' and how the church needs to be vigilant against the planting of weeds by the enemy. These weeds can produce a paralyzing effect on the believer. There was also a powerful prophetic series called 'crossover' which constituted the preaching towards the latter part of the Prayer and Fasting.

The prophetic promise passage for this fasting and prayer was from Isaiah 55:12-13 - "For you shall go out in joy and be led forth in peace; the mountains and the hills before you shall break forth into singing, and all the trees of the field shall clap their hands. Instead of the thorn shall come up the cypress; instead of the brier shall come up the myrtle; and it shall make a name for the Lord, an everlasting sign that shall not be cut off."

Key Features:

1. An extra ordinary burden gripped the heart of the believers and the leaders of the church for the city of Edmonton and the Nation of Canada: This drove many of our people to drive through the city throughout the night and pray.
2. Baptism in the Holy Spirit: People were baptized in the Holy Spirit for the first time and most of them were young people. They were ministered to by the Lord in the most unusual manner even through dreams. Some of them felt so strongly that their whole body was on fire while they were sleeping. Few of them sensed that they were being electrocuted by the Power of the Lord. There were also reports of the Power of God falling on people while they were sitting in weddings and their mouths opening in an irresistible manner to speak in unknown tongues. This experience continued as there were more reports of people coming under the Power of God while they drove back home after the meetings. The most fascinating aspect is that these happened to be people who were never exposed to anything supernatural and unusual before.



3. There was such a powerful anointing of prayer that was seen almost every night. People continued to pray sometimes until 2 am in the morning. These precious people were seen sitting in groups and alone in a room or space available in the church. Once again, a lot of them were young people who were gripped by this anointing of prayer.
4. Powerful prophetic ministries were seen manifesting in the church with such detail. The names of people, places, and significant dates were given by the Lord, even in dreams, to those who were prophesying. The church noticed that there was a marked shift in the ministries and anointing of all who ministered in this fasting Prayer and Fasting; and this still continues.
5. The church, fervently moved by the Holy Spirit, had the most powerful prayer for

the Nation of Canada and this time there was something distinctly uncommon. The church celebrated the blessed connection that Canada has with the Nation of Israel. The flags of the two nations were hosted and joined in prayer signifying not only the unassailable connection that Canada has with Israel but also the connection our church will have with Israel in the days to come. The church prayed mightily for missions across the globe and especially the ministries of TAMI and its leadership.

The remarkable part is that this move that began in the Prayer and Fasting seems to indicate that it is here to stay, will gain greater momentum and have more intensity in the days to come. Ever since the Prayer and Fasting came to an end, the church is experiencing a powerful move of the Holy Spirit even in its regular Sunday services. As more and more new people are drawn to the church, we say, "More Lord, More."
